

Time and Cost

Corporate volunteer sorting sessions are held in the boutique and run for 2.5 hours, between 1:30pm-4:00pm. The sessions are held on nonclient days.

Clothing sale set up and pack down is offered a few times per year, with dates and times to be advised.

The cost of participating in a corporate volunteering session is \$500 plus gst. This is for between 5-6 participants.
